I would like to thank you all for praying for my father. He did have to fly down to South Africa where he had various tests performed. It ap-

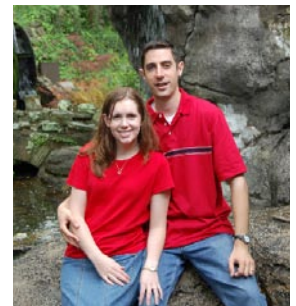

The timing of the work papers processing and arrival of the container has to be precise, which we know God is able to accomplish! It is so exciting to watch everything fall into place and to see the Lord provide. We will conclude this month in NY, with our last mission's conference.
